




The Nervous System

5 2 major divisions

1) Central nervous system → within the bones


- * The brain → within the skull
- * Spinal cord → within vertebral canal



2) Peripheral nervous system


(a) Autonomic nervous system (ANS)

Supplies involuntary structures (cardiac & smooth muscles)



Sympathetic

Parasympathetic



(B) Somatic nerves (SNS) → voluntary structures, body wall and limbs

* cranial (12 pairs) → connected to brain


* spinal (31 pair) → connected to spinal cord

The brain

① cerebrum


→ 2 cerebral hemispheres separated from each other by a median fissure

→ Diencephalon

- * medulla



Functional classification of Neurons

1 Afferent (sensory)


* Convey info from tissues & organs into Central nervous system (CNS)



2 Efferent (motor)

* Transmit Signals from the CNS to effector organs (muscles & glands)






Trigeminal → Sensory

VIII - Vestibulocochlear


