





The ignorance puzzle... Skewed info.

1) the personal bias

We have all different experiences from communities and people we meet Also, The majority of our neighbourhoods are not representative, giving a very biased view of how life on this planet is

2) outdated bias

Teachers tend to teach outdated worldviews, also books contribute to this bias

3) News bias

An excellent journalist knows how to pick the story that will make headlines and people will read it because it's sensational, unusual events are more interesting, no? Also they're exaggerated especially things we're afraid of.

A shark attacked a Swedish person for example!

Intuition

Exaggerating what we afraid of, seeing causality when there's none and getting an illusion of confidence

Is this important {Eliminating ignorance}?!

Actually, yes, it's important to understand extreme poverty and knowing how tofight it how to bring girls in schools

Also, if you have a fact-based worldview of today, you might have the chance to understand what's coming next in the future

(With giving an example of people who can afford to fly abroad with an airplane for

a vacation)









2 How to solve this?!

1) measure it

Helping to understand what is the pattern of ignorance

2) cure it

people like shortcuts, we need to turn our intuition into strength, we need to be able to generalise

misconception of the rule of thumb

- 1] everything is getting worse
- => The other way to think is most of things improve, don't go to the worse!
- 2] there are rich and poor, the gap is increasing, there is an inequality!
- => It's not an equal world, but when we look at the data, it's one hump!
- 3] countries and people need to be very very rich to get social developments
- => That's wrong, the Hugh hump is in the middle, already we have girls in school for example, just go to the majority who already have this (electricity girls in school....)
- 4] sharks are dangerous
- => actually sharks kill only very very few)
