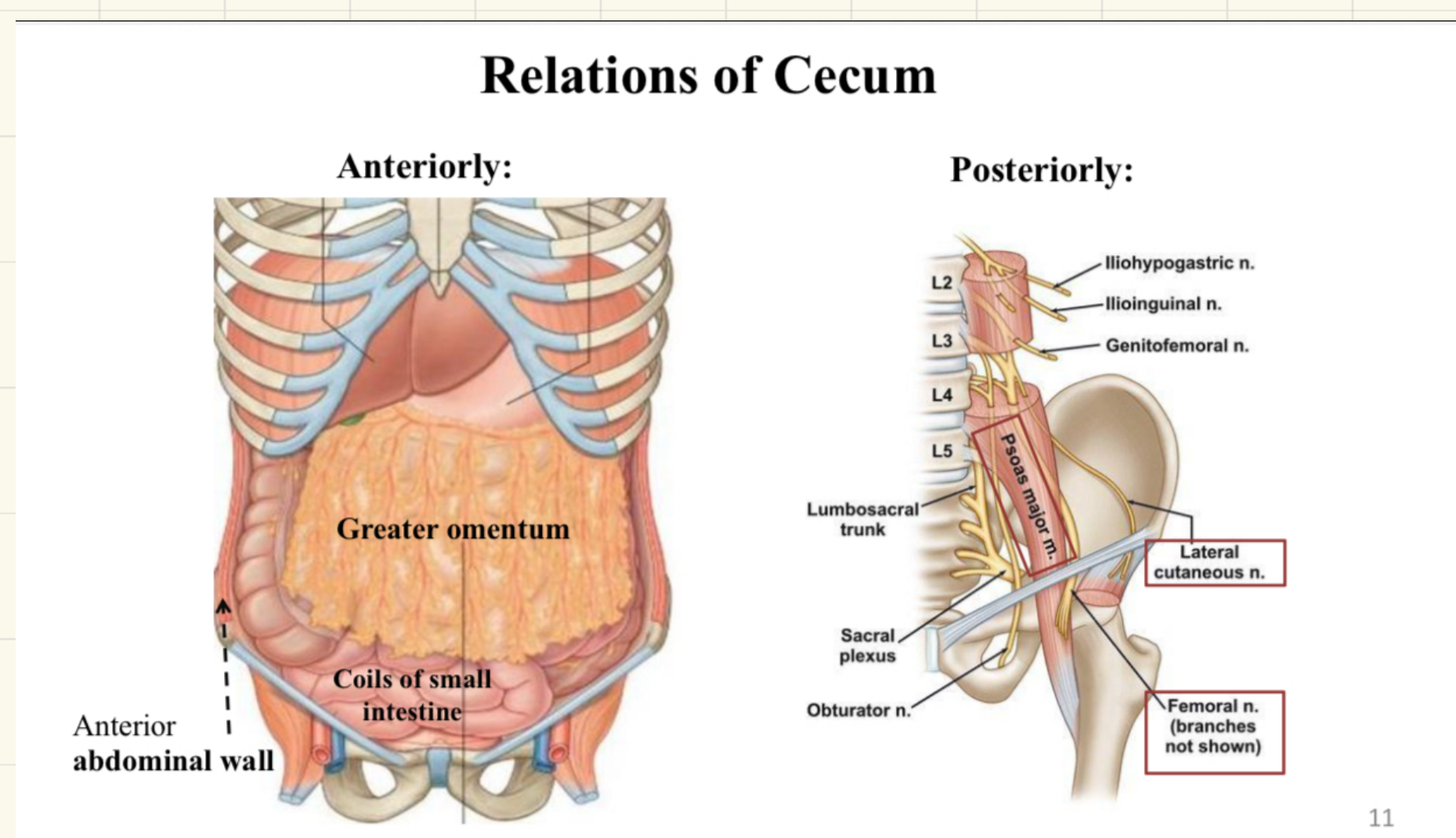


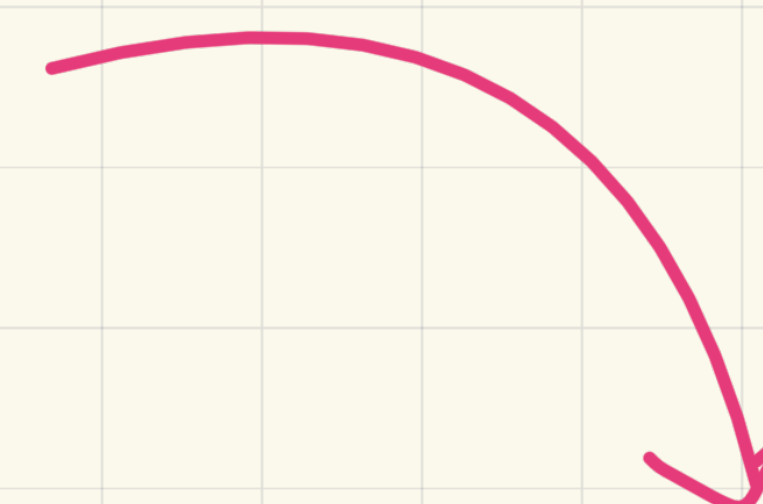

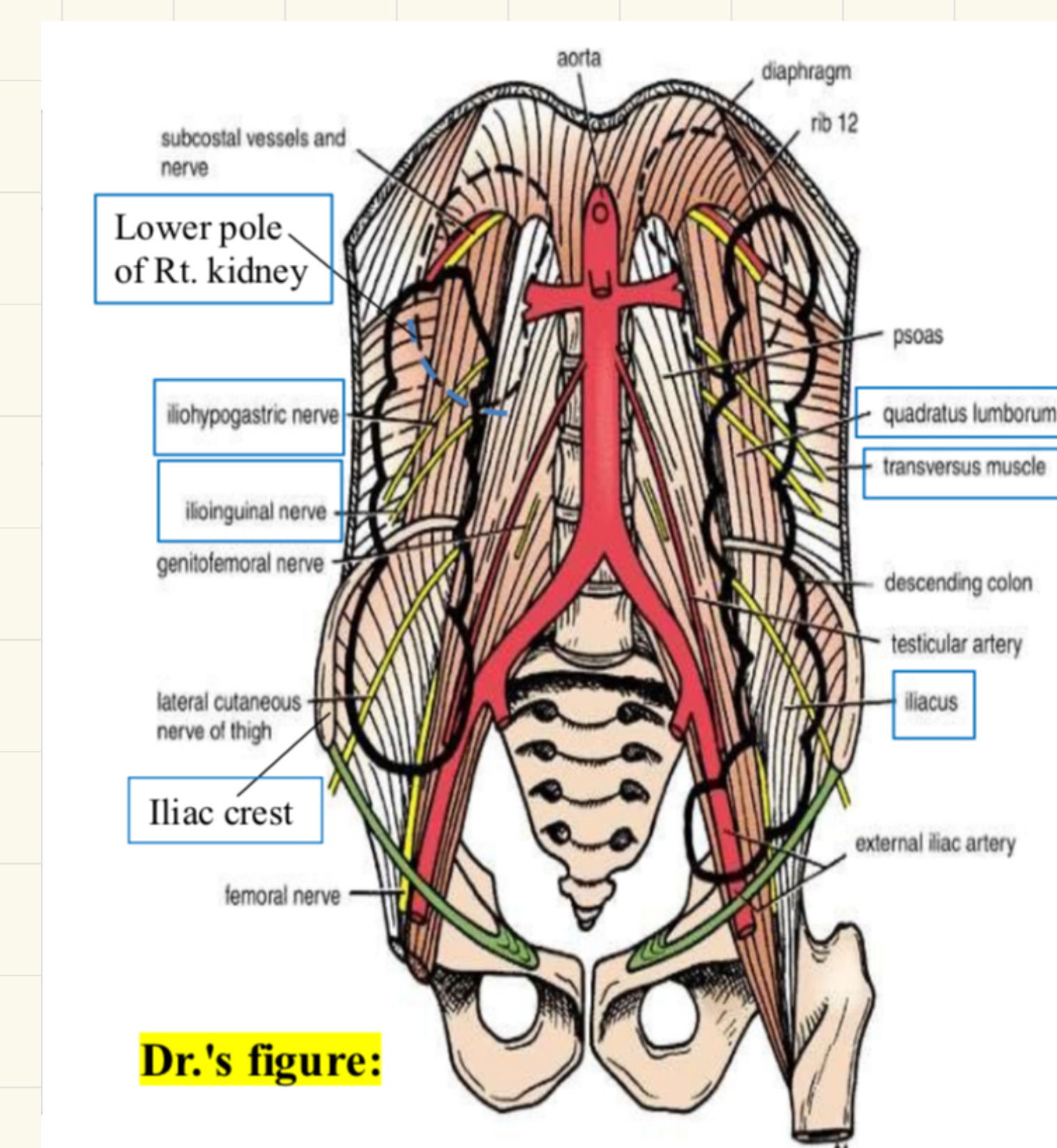


Anterior	1) Anterior Abdominal wall 2) Greater Omentum 3) Coils of small intestine

Postero-Medial	The Appendix

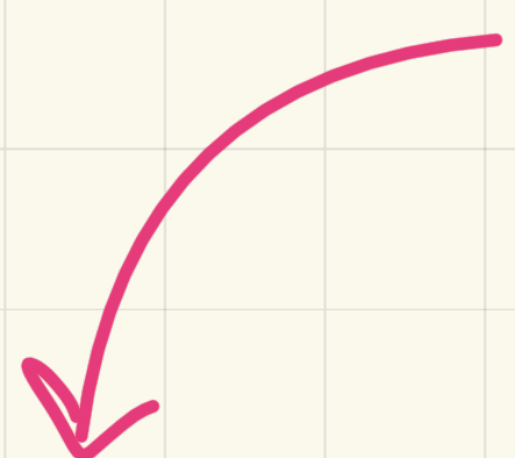
2) Ascending Colon &



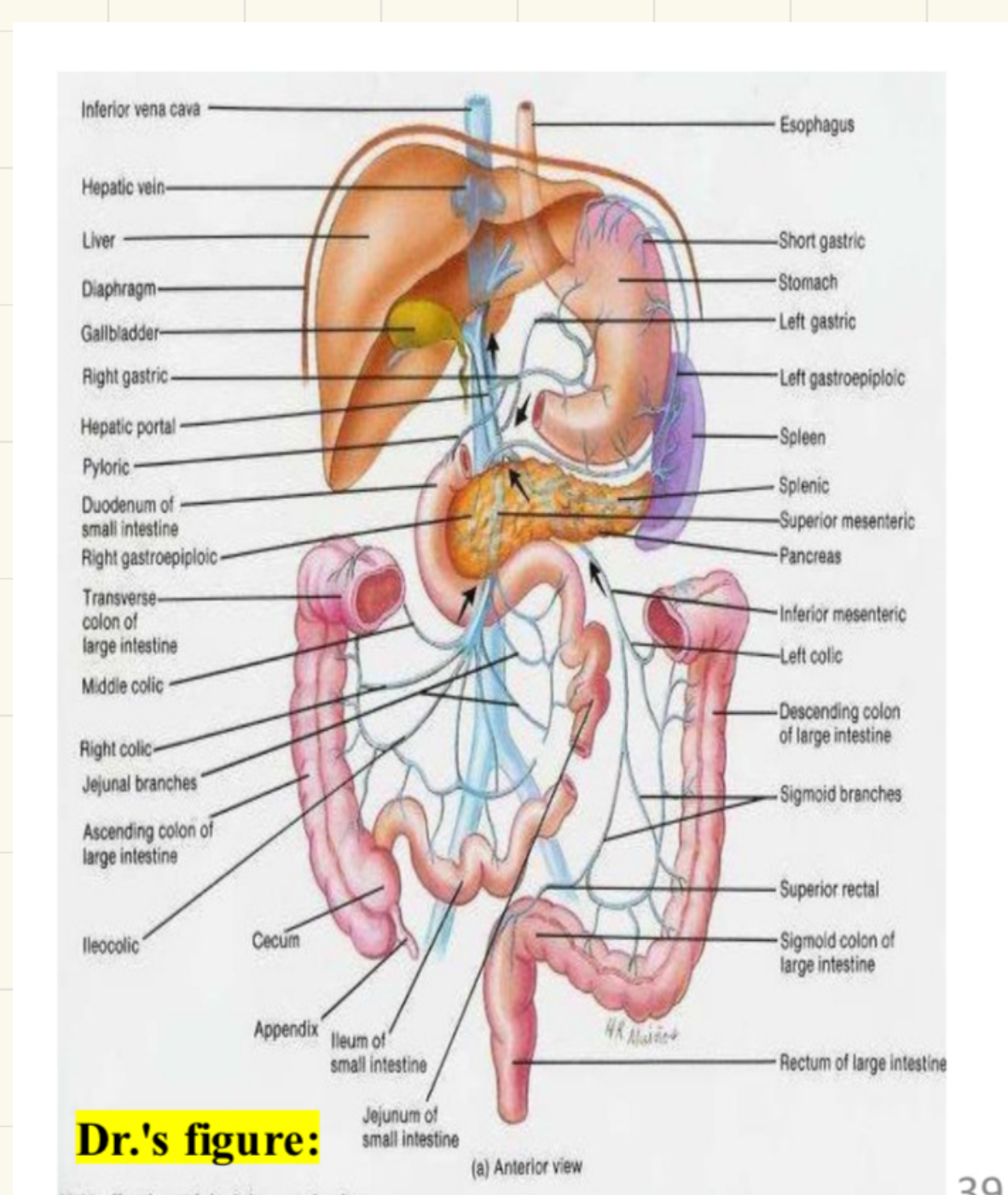
Anterior	1) Anterior Abdominal wall 2) Greater Omentum 3) Coils of small intestine
