### **General Instructions**

- Write at least 6 paragraphs.
  - Detail and discuss your main results.
  - Explain findings theme by theme.
  - Compare your results with previous literature.
  - It is important to cite more than 3 papers.
- 

### **Discussion Content Structure**

- Present and explain each theme separately.
  - Discuss how your findings relate to existing studies.
  - Highlight similarities and differences with literature.
- 

### **Implications**

- Discuss the implications of your findings.
  - Explain how your results contribute to knowledge or practice.
- 

### **Limitations**

(This preferred to be written as a separate paragraph with a subheading)

Examples of limitations:

- Sample characteristics (e.g., all males or all females)
  - Researcher bias (e.g., all researchers interviewed females and participants felt shy to answer)
  - Sample size
- 

### **Strengths**

Examples:

- Large sample size
- Use of triangulation

- Inclusion of all academic years
  - Well-prepared interviewees
- 

### **Recommendations**

- Write a separate paragraph.
  - Suggest future directions based on your findings.
  - Example:
    - Conduct mixed methodology studies
    - Include quantitative research
- 

### **Conclusion**

- Write one or two paragraphs.
- Summarize the entire study briefly.
- Highlight the main findings and overall message.
